Estimated time = 40 mins

Gurriculum Extract:

Number - addition and subtraction:

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers
- Solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems such as 7 = _ - 9.
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100

Key Terms:

- **Code** A set of symbols (such as shapes, letters or numbers) used to represent secret meanings.
- Sculpture A sculpture is an artwork that is made by carving, modelling or placing materials together to create a 3D (three dimensional) object. They can be made out of stone, wood, clay or any other material the artist wants to use!
- Public Something that is open for everyone to see.
- **Commission** When an artist is asked by a person/organisation to create an artwork.

Activity Instructions

Work out the subtractions to discover the title of an artwork on display in Liverpool Biennial 2021. The title is made up of 2 words – there are 7 letters in the $1^{\rm st}$ word and 5 letters in the $2^{\rm nd}$ word. Can you find them all?

- 1. First, find the answers to the subtractions.
- 2. Then, use the code to find the letters that are represented by the numbers. Write this letter next to your number in the subtraction.
- 3. Once you have found all the answers, you will have the letters to unlock the title of the artwork that can be seen at Canning Dock on the waterfront of the city centre.
